SWIMMING N.Z. COMPETITIVE REGISTRATION FEE

The 2010 - 2011 Swimming N. Z. Competitive registration fee \$80.50

Each swimmer that wishes to compete at swim meets is required to be registered as competitive. The registration fee is from July 1st – 30th June the following year. This fee goes to Counties Manukau and Swimming New Zealand so swimmers can be put onto the database. Some of the money is allocated to our regional body and some to Swimming N. Z. (SNZ) for swimming initiatives and funds for our top athletes. If you want to compete in meets outside of the club, you will need to pay the N.Z. Registration Fee.

CLUB MEMBERSHIP FEE

<u>Club Membership Fees</u> - 1 Child \$60.00 <u>OR</u> Family (2 or more children) \$100.00 <u>DUE 1ST</u> SEPTEMBER 2010.

This is an annual fee members pay to PSC for being a member of the club. The payment helps the club to pay for – Club Relays, Winter Leagues, Club Nights, Incentive Prizes, Administration, Insurances, Engraving trophies etc. *All swimmers swimming twice a week or more, club membership is compulsory.*

. GST INCREASE 1ST OCTOBER

WITH THE GST INCREASING ON 1ST OCTOBER 2010, ALL FEES WILL BE INCREASED TO ACCOMMODATE THE 2.5% INCREASE.

MEMBERS WITH OUTSTANDING FEES ARE ENCOURAGED TO GET YOUR PAYMENTS IN BEFORE FRIDAY 1ST OCTOBER BEFORE THE 2.5% INCREASE IN GST.

COACHING FEES

Coaching Fees are paid each term for swimmers training. The fees are based on the amount of times you are swimming and how long your pool sessions are. Every swimmer will be given an invoice for their term's swimming at the beginning of each term. The fees are used to pay Pool Hire and Coaches' time.

Please pay term 3 fees to the Squad Managers – Andrea McLean and Annette Hirst poolside; place into Orange Locker 79 with details on cheque; OR alternatively paid electronically into our account.

NOTE: THE TERM 4 COACHING FEES WILL INCORPORATE THE 2.5% GST INCREASE EFFECTIVE FROM FRIDAY 1ST OCTOBER

POOL HIRE

The club have been able to provide more swim meets since the Rec Centre was certified as a qualifying pool, which in turn has given extra opportunities for swimmers to qualify for National meets. It is great to see swimmers utilise the extra club nights. We work hard at trying to keep costs to a minimum, however pool hire is extremely expensive and an area we have no control over. The entry fee swimmers are charged goes towards pool hire costs for each meet.

ALLOCATED TRAINING SESSIONS

The Coaching team work hard at allocating all swimmers into the different training session times for the various squad/fitness groups. If swimmers are unable to commit to the times allocated then they must change squad/fitness groups that suit e.g. A swimmer allocated a squad that trains for 5 sessions, but can only commit to train 3 or 4 sessions a week, must change squads. We are at capacity, and it is unfair to hold a place in the squad if you are unable to commit to its requirements. Contact your coach if you are unable to attend a training session, especially with planned holidays. Swimmers with unaccounted absences will be replaced.
